MEMBERSHIP RENEWALS



Around the second week of August, we will be emailing everyone an invitation to renew their u3a membership for the year September 2023-August 2024. If you joined after May this year, you will not receive this invitation as your membership runs until August 2024 anyway. If you're reading this in hard copy, your renewal invitation will be sent to you by post.

The easiest way to renew will be online via the Beacon Portal, a link to which will be included. You will need a Beacon account which can be set up using the details set out

in the invitation: If you have already set up an account, you only need your email address and chosen password. You can pay by credit or debit card.

If you are unable to renew using the Beacon system, you will, as in previous years, still be able to make an electronic bank transfer (BACS) or we will accept payment by cheque, with instructions on these methods of payment being included within the email you receive in August.

Additionally, this year we will have a presence to showcase our u3a at the Godalming Staycation event on Wednesday morning, 9th August. (See details elsewhere in this Newsletter). I will be there from 10.00am and I will be happy to accept renewal payments (cheques only, please) on that day plus membership applications for any friends you may like to bring along! 
